County Reorganization

9 Health Cirrus MD Update

9 Health Fair Representatives Amy Friel and Alex Andrews were present to discuss options for further promoting telehealth services to the residents of Dolores County through the Cirrus MD pilot program. A small number of interested parties during the initial registration period prompted the discussion. Efforts will be made to reach the public through alternative social media sources such as Facebook and the County website to target part time workers and those within the community without health benefits.

Community Voice County Road Use Discussion and Possible Approval

Community Voice Representative Ronda Lancaster and local outdoor enthusiast Rick Gersch were present to discuss plans for an upcoming ATV fundraiser. June 26, 2021 is the proposed fundraiser date. Presented were various plotted mapped routes for ATV's and bike riders. The routes would traverse over multiple Dolores County roads. The BOCC directed Community Voice to pursue a Special Event Permit to work out the details associated with the events.

Congresswoman Lauren Boebert's Office Staff Meet and Greet

Colorado Congresswoman Lauren Boebert's aide Devin Camacho joined the meeting to introduce himself as a contact person and to offer assistance and representation to Dolores County on behalf of the Congresswoman.

Road and Bridge Road Update

Designated Truck Route Discussion: Air Products and Kinder Morgan representatives will be invited to attend a meeting with the BOCC to discuss truck routes within the County.

Forest Service Update

US Forest Service Representatives Tom Rice and Derek Padilla joined the meeting. The BOCC visited with Mr. Rice about FS policies in regards to seasonal road closures.

Mr. Padilla shared that the Salter Environmental Assessment review required some editing and would be available in 2-3 weeks.

The 13 miles north of Mancos Chicken Creek Environmental Assessment was signed.

The Rico Trails Environmental Assessment had no objections to the new 8.7 miles of trails designated to the Colorado Trails Alliance.

Pile burning will resume now that there is snow on the ground.

BLM Update

Bureau of Land Management Tres Rios Field Manager Connie Clementson introduced the new Canyon of the Ancients Monument Manager Ray O’Niel.

There is one day remaining for protests on the Painted Hand Trail reroute in Montezuma County.

The Transportation Access Plan has had two appeals.

The Black Snag and Disappointment Pits contracts will soon be issued. Stock piles will be removed after the NEPA review.

Plans for Road and Bridge access to the Dolores River are being pursued.

New Business

Resolution to Amend the 2020 Budget/Conservation Trust #2

Dolores County authorizes expenditures in excess of the amount of the amount approved in the Dolores Count Budget for the calendar year 2020, as shown below:

- Conservation Trust Funds in the amount of \$14,350.00 for a capital improvement project.
