AGENDAS PURSUANT TO CRS 24-6-402(2)(III)**

IT WAS RESOLVED:

WHEREAS, the Dove Creek Press is currently the official newspaper of record in Dolores County; and

WHEREAS, the Dove Creek Press has ceased being published consistently; and

WHEREAS, it is the statutory duty of the BOCC to designate an official newspaper of general circulation in the County for purpose of publishing legal notice; and

WHEREAS, the Cortez Journal is the nearest newspaper of general circulation within Dolores County; and

WHEREAS, CRS 24-6-402(2)(III) authorizes the BOCC to utilize the County Website as the official posting location for all County meeting notices and agendas; and

WHEREAS, the posting of BOCC meetings notices and agendas on the County Website is an effective and cost-effective method authorized by the Legislature.

THEREFORE, upon motion made and seconded, and unanimous vote taken, the BOCC hereby DESIGNATES THE CORTEZ JOURNAL as the official newspaper of general circulation within the County for the purpose of publishing legal notice.

FURTHER, the County Website is hereby designated as the location for posting all County meeting notices and agendas. In addition, such postings will be made on the Dolores County Courthouse doors.
