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EVENT RULES

Competitors must participate in 3 of the 4 hosted Rodeos to be eligible for yearend awards.

Ages are based on the age of the participant as of midnight December 31st, and only 19 year olds that are just out of high school can compete.

11 & Under Saturday - Check-in is at 8:30am, bring entry fee and completed permission slip. Rodeo will start at 9:00am.

12 & Up Sunday - Check-in is at 8:30am, bring entry fee and completed permission slip. Rodeo will start at 9:00 am.

Points Points will be given on a 5 and/or 10 point scale. For example 1st place gets 5 pts, 2nd place gets 4 pts, 3rd place gets 3 pts, 4th place gets 2 pts, with all other participants receiving 1 pt. For the series awards, winners will be based off of the best of three rodeos.

5 & Under Five year olds will need to specify between the prize only and tack series categories. Participation is limited to one of the categories. This age group is for participants that need to be lead or walked by, there will be no times taken and no series awards given. If you have a 5 yr old that can do it by his or herself or they need help but want to be entered in the series awards then they can compete in the 5-8 age group, but if they get help then they will get rolled to the bottom under the kids that can do it without help.

Events will start with the 5 & under doing a small barrel and poles pattern. Next, will be the stick horse races, these will be split into two age groups of 2-3 year olds and 4-5 year olds. Last, will be the dummy roping event, which will have all three age groups (5 & under, 5-8, and 9-11) in the arena at the same time.

NEW!! Ranch Roping Event – Contestants will draw a number and must rope their number from a small herd of numbered cattle in the arena. Contestants will have unlimited loops during a 2 minute period. Time will be “flag to flag”

Go to event list for remaining event order.

For the All Around awards, if there are **four** or less in the boys or girls groups, then the two groups will be combined. (If in the event of a tied score, there will be a tie-breaker event to determine the winner.)

If there are **four** or less participants per age group there will be no saddle given.
