Discussion Regarding San Juan County Road Accessibility and Road Maintenance on Bug and Cedar Point

The Dolores County Road and Bridge Department has maintained the roads on Bug Point and Cedar Point for many years through an agreement from 1987 with San Juan County Utah. San Juan County recently contacted Dolores County stating that they will begin maintaining the Bug Point Road; however, they would like Dolores County to continue to maintain the Cedar Point Road. The changes brought forth discussions and concerns in regards to liability insurance for work and equipment completed across state lines.

Dolores County Attorney Golbricht visited with a representative from the County's liability insurance company CTSI. Dolores County would have equipment coverage and liability coverage while maintaining roads in San Juan County.

Attorney Golbricht will draft a contract with San Juan County for maintenance on the Cedar Point Road.

Road 40J Update


Attorney Golbricht attended a State Land Board meeting in Greeley, Colorado. Several representatives from San Miquel County were present in an attempt to again have the portion of the road which crosses Section 16 designated as a public road.

Commissioner Cook adjourned the meeting.
