West Fork Fire Building Bid Award Approval

Sealed Bid Requests for Proposals (RFP's) for a 60x60 insulated metal building with a concrete slab and a 20-foot concrete apron to be constructed for the West Fork Fire Association were due by March 4, 2022 at 4:00p.m. A request for bids for living quarters within the 60x60 structure details were described under the Alternate #1 RFP. Four bids were received by the deadline and opened during the regularly scheduled BOCC meeting on March 7.

West Fork Fire Association members reviewed the bids and provided their recommendation to the BOCC.

Commissioner Kibel made a motion awarding Cruzan Construction the West Fork Fire Building project.
Commissioner Garchar seconded the motion.
All three Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

County Administrator Margret Daves was directed to contact all of the bidders with the results and to proceed with finalizing the contract and bond details. Expenses will be paid as needed to meet the previously received reimbursement grant requirements. A deposit will be made to assist with the initial costs associated with the ordering of the building.
