Proposition 123/Shak Powers Region 9

Shak Powers with Region 9 presented to the BOCC information regarding Proposition 123 Affordable Housing. Several hundred million dollars of affordable housing will become available in the second half of 2023 due to the enactment of Proposition 123 by Colorado voters in 2022. This funding will be overseen by DOLA and the Governor's Office of Economic Development and International Trade, and may be granted or loaned to Non-Profits, Community Land Trusts, Private Entities and Local Governments. Organizations are only eligible for this funding if their project or program takes place in municipalities, counties, or tribes that have committed to increasing their affordable housing stock above a baseline amount. Dolores County needs to accept commitment by November 1, 2023. The BOCC decided they would like to gather more information before making a decision.

Social Services Update/Malynda Evans

Social Services Director Malynda Evans presented for approval the Record of Proceedings for October 2, 2023 as well as the financial documents through August 2023.

Commissioner Yellowman made a motion approving the above-mentioned documents. Commissioner Cook seconded the motion.

All three Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Ms. Evans brought to the Town of Dove Creek goodie bags with blankets, gloves, granola bars etc., to hand out to the community from the LEAP program, which starts in November.

Ms. Evans introduced to the BOCC Katie Herrmann, the new Adult and Child Protection Services Case Worker.

Rico Snow Removal

Chauncey McCarthey Rico Town Manager wanted to discuss with the BOCC the Rico winter snow removal. In past years if the Town of Rico has been unable to keep up with the snow removal from the Town streets the Dolores County Road and Bridge Department comes to assist as their time allows. Mr. McCarthey originally requested an IGA to memorialize the arrangement. After discussion, the BOCC decided that it would simply confirm the arrangement in the minutes.

Commissioner Cook made a motion to approve the assistance by Dolores County Road and Bridge to the Town of Rico for snow removal at the discretion of the Road and Bridge Superintendent in terms of timing and availability.

Commissioner Yellowman seconded the motion.

All three Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Special Events Information/Keith Keesling EMS Director

Dolores County EMS Director Keith Keesling discussed with the BOCC and the Town of Rico that any and all special events large or small should be brought to the attention of the Dolores County Sheriff and the EMS Director for the purpose of preparation and extra availability of Emergency Services during these events.

Mr. Keesling also runs the Dolores County Food Bank. He brought a Refrigerator and Freezer for the food bank that will be starting up in the Town of Rico.

Road Maintenance Material IGA with San Miguel County

Dolores County Road and Bridge Department previously entered into an IGA with San Miguel County regarding road maintenance material.

Commissioner Cook made a motion to ratify the already executed Road Maintenance Material IGA with San Miguel County.

Commissioner Yellowman seconded the motion.
